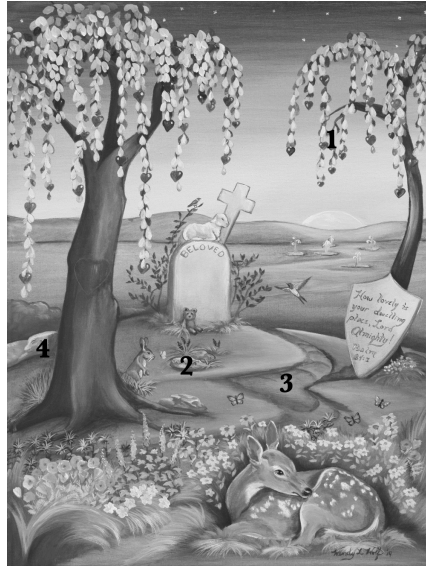


“ All God’s Children”

This is a Biblical Storypainting comprised of three parts, a hidden picture image, a narration, and a hidden picture key. It is a work of art designed to get people to interact with The Bible, the image, and each other.

It’s purpose is to help you to remember and repeat the story, to be a door to open dialogue with others, and to be an aid in sharing the Good News of the Gospel.

You interact with this storypainting using your Bible and the provided narration, then read the designated vs. and find the hidden pictures associated with them.

This particular image, “All God’s Children” is designed to offer some comfort to those who have lost a child, and can be ordered with personalization as a memorial piece. It is designed around Psalm 84.

“ **All God’s Children**” follows Psalm 84, starting with vs 1.

The beginning of Psalm 84 reminds us that our loved one is in the most beautiful place of all (vs1)

The young fawn rests in a beautiful place, protected and loved...as does your beloved.

This painting has been designed full of visible vibrant life, flowers, gentle animals, butterfly’s, all beautiful things, but their beauty is fleeting, as they are of this world. The painting also contains The Lamb, The Cross, and The Grave.. representing Jesus, his ultimate sacrifice on the cross, triumph over the grave, and the opening of the door to **permanent everlasting life** for those that believe in him.

You will notice a sparrow, a swallow and a nest (vs 3), The artist has interpreted the symbolism in vs 3 as the sparrow being a child that has found a house with The Lord, and the swallow, a parent, who has comfort in knowing that they lay their young in the safest place of all, with Almighty God.

After reading vs 3, what is your personal interpretation of the meaning behind the sparrow, the swallow, and nest?

The path, our “way” (vs 5) through this life, following God’s way, blessed with his strength in our hearts.

The trees are made to look like weeping trees, the leaves tear drops shed over love... they represent The Valley of Baca, meaning The Valley of Weeping, in the distance is the place of springs and blessings (vs 6) then finally the Sun (representing God in Zion) (vs 7)

The Sun and Shield in the painting represent God, and his ultimate Grace.. the shield is referred to in both vs 9 and vs 11, what does the shield mean to you?

We travel the path through the valley of weeping, past the grave, to the place of blessings.. assured that God withholds no good thing from those who walk uprightly (vs 11)

Oh Lord, Blessed is the man who trusts in you (vs 12)
